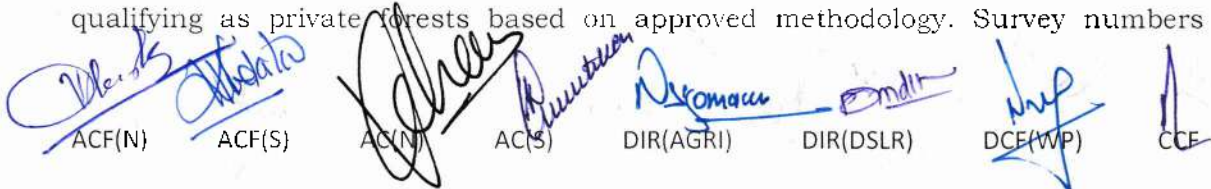

The public hearing scheduled for the day is being conducted for the areas qualifying as private forests based on approved methodology. Survey numbers

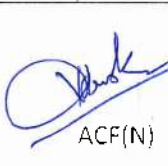
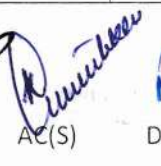

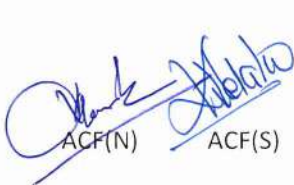
It has been decided to recall the objector/representative at sr. no. 2, 4, 6, 20, 26 for the next hearing to give last opportunity to present his say before the review committee.
